The last day of school will be May 27th. That will be Spring Fling day for the students and **dismissal will be at 1:30 p.m.**, unless there is a delay in the morning.

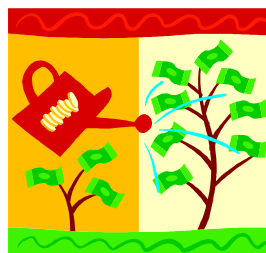
RECYCLING FOR THE ART ROOM

CALCULATOR RACE

Grade level: K-5 **Materials:** calculator

Skill: Adding and Subtracting

Subtraction: Each partner needs a calculator. Begin by punching 21 on the calculator. Two players alternate turns. During their turn they must subtract 1, 2, 3 from the number on the calculator. Continue until one person reaches zero. If a negative number is reached – the other person is the winner.

Addition: Each partner needs a calculator. Begin by starting with 0 on the calculator. Two players alternate turns. During their turn they must add 1, 2, 3 to the number on the calculator. Continue until one person reaches 21. The first person to reach 21 is the winner.
